## ***. RESEARCH***

Following the M1 Kegworth air crash on the 8 January 1989. I collated clinical material and documented the injuries sustained by victims of the air crash.

As a result of research carried out, a number of review articles and publications of the findings of the accident have been produced. In addition I have extensively lectured and given scientific papers, both nationally and internationally, on aspects related to the incident. A major finding of the study was to identify a new crash 'brace' position that will protect occupants involved in an impact air crash.

***Thesis :- Impact Biomechanics of the Pelvis and Lower Limbs In Impact Aircraft Accidents***

From the clinical data collected from the M1 air crash it became apparent that preconceived ideas as to injury causation may be incorrect. The studies indicated that severe lower limb injuries could be sustained in the absence of secondary impacts, and that the position the lower limbs adopt can effect the injuries seen.
