Simon Williams has been a Consultant Urologist in Derby for eight years. His main area of interest is surgery on kidneys; either removal for cancer or non-function, or reconstruction if obstructed. Mainly this surgery is done laparoscopically ("keyhole surgery"). However, like all consultant urologists, he sees and operates on patients with all urological problems.

Mr. Richard Wilson MD, FRCS

Consultant Vascular Surgeon



Areas of expertise:

- Varicose veins - clinic based "walk-in-walk-out" radiofrequency treatment
- Cosmetic thread veins - clinic based sclerotherapy
- Botox for sweating disorders
- Peripheral vascular disease - angioplasty and bypass
- Aortic aneurysms - open and keyhole repair
- Stroke prevention and carotid surgery
- Leg and arm pain or swelling

Mr. Wilson's initial training, in Derby and Nottingham, was followed by two years of complex endovascular surgery in Adelaide and Newcastle, then two years as a Consultant Vascular Surgeon in London.

He also provides outpatient clinic based endovenous treatments for varicose veins, thread veins and venous ulcers, thus avoiding the need for an operation.
